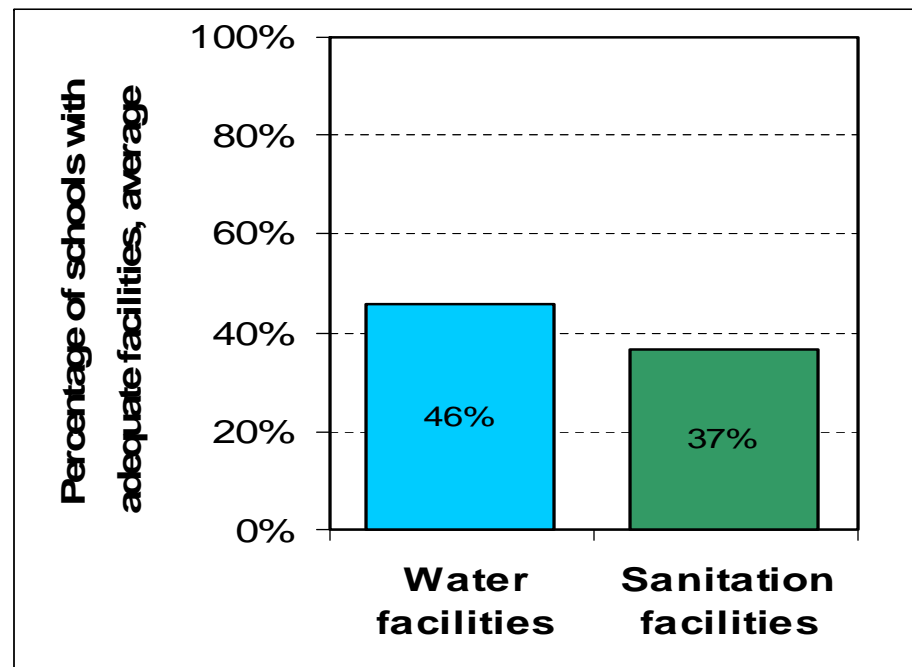

2010: Call for Action for WASH in Schools

Target: Ensure that all schools have adequate child-friendly water and sanitation facilities, and hygiene education programmes

Growing recognition

- *That schools and learning centers need to be safe, healthy and protective (Quality Learning Environments – CFS)*
- *Water, sanitation and hygiene are crucial factors for school attendance and completion, in particular for girls*
- *And more resources and commitment required from both National governments and partners*

It is time to act to scale up WASH in Schools Programming as we have the experience and know how to do this.

2010: Call for Action for WASH in Schools

Target: Ensure that all schools have adequate child-friendly water and sanitation facilities, and hygiene education programmes

Process for Call for Action

- ***UNICEF, Water For People and Water Advocates joined efforts to build up global advocacy to call Policy and Decision Makers to act on WASH in Schools***
- ***A 16 pager call for Action booklet is under drafting stage***
- ***WASH in School Partners were recently contacted to contribute with their success stories on WASH in schools programming for Call to Action booklet***
- ***Booklet will be ready by November 2009 and will be used as advocacy tool in 2010 for a Call to Action on WASH in Schools***
