Transboundary Freshwater Dispute Database (TFDD)

Searchable online database

(www.transboundarywaters.orst.edu)

- Reference to 3,600 water-related treaties (805-1997)
- Full-text of over 400 treaties and 40 US compacts
- GIS layers (population, land coverage, water stress, etc.)
- ...



Document Collection

Collection of water-relevant documents

- Policy Documents: Master Plans, Policies, Strategies
- Legal Documents: Water Act, Regulations, Statutes, etc.

Local language and English

Stored in the ReWaB searchable database
(Country, Language, Sector, metadata)



Document Indexing

Identification of text passages related to functions and process features

“Indexed” documents are stored in the ReWaB searchable database (Country, Language, Function, Process Feature)



Document Analysis

Level of coverage of functions and process features in policy and legal documents

Qualitative analysis by sub-function and feature: e.g. most/least developed sub-functions, correspondence between policy content and legal instruments, outstanding trends.
